# Rules and Regulations

Limit 25 teams

All entries must be turned in before the day of the event.

Return registration forms to the Wray Chamber of Commerce, Calvary Lutheran Church, Bonanza Ford, Foltmer Drug, Lala's Bakery or Joe's Liquor Mart with registration fee attached.

## Cooking:

- Chili May contain any ingredients
- Each team must bring their own ingredients
- Electricity is first come first serve. So be prepared to bring your own source of power/fuel
- You may precook meat
- Any of the following may be prepared beforehand: Canned or bottled tomatoes, beans, tomato sauce, peppers, pepper sauce, broth and spices.
- All other preparation must be done during the cooking time.
- Setup/Cooking time starts at 7am. You must be ready to serve by 11am.

## Set up: 7am

- You must bring your own tables, chairs, canopy, cooking items/utensils, power strips or power/fuel source.
- You must bring your own container to collect judging tickets (jar, bucket, can)
- Set up will begin at 7am Sat Oct 21st.
- The Calvary Lutheran Church will provide you with sampling cups and spoons. A regular size bowl will be given so they can have a bowl of their favorite chili after judging.
- Please decorate your area in tail gate style (Example Football themes).
- Signs and any other decorations are encouraged to fit your tailgate theme.
- Special Tailgate Decorating award will be given (the Calvary Lutheran Church Youth Group will judge this portion). The prize is a Traegar Tailgator 20 donated by Appearance Edge and Yuma CO. Abstract.
- be prepared to serve a minimum of 6 gallons of chili
- BE READY TO SERVE AT 11AM UNTIL 1PM.

- \$350 1<sup>st</sup> place, \$200 2<sup>nd</sup> place and \$150 3<sup>rd</sup> place cash prizes will be awarded
- Winners will be announced at 2pm in the park.
- All cleanup and any damages to property is your responsibility. If you do not comply with this rule you will not be allowed to participate in this event again for 5 years.
- You are not fully registered until you return the first page signed and with the full registration fee!
